

Piedmont Futurity

Founded in 1992, the Piedmont Breeders' Futurity includes the top stallions in the Paso Fino Breed. The Piedmont Futurity has become a showcase for the offspring of these top stallions. For a one time fee, owners enter their stallions into the Breeders' Futurity. Any foals out of these Stallions can then be registered with the Piedmont Futurity at a small fee with multiple opportunities to win cash prizes. Over \$250,000 has been awarded since the first class in 1993.

All Piedmont Futurity registered offspring of a nominated stallion are eligible to compete for prize money as a yearling in Bella Forma and as a four year old under saddle in the Pleasure, Performance and Fino Divisions. All geldings have an additional bonus to compete as five year olds.

Cese and Pat Figueroa have owned and operated Tuckaway Farm in Landrum, SC since 1994. Cese began training horses in his hometown of Vieques, Puerto Rico and then moved to the United States, working farms across the country from Florida to Texas. Pat grew up in Miami, Florida working with Paso's, which is how she met Cese. Their love of the Paso, and unique training techniques, combined to build the successful farm that we know today.

Tuckaway Farm is a full service training facility that offers horse consultations, training of all breeds for trail & show, clinics, and riding lessons for all ages. They have trained quarter horses, walking horses and Paso Finos. Their clients have collectively won more ribbons and trophies than could ever be counted, including Grand Championships in youth and amateur-owner classes over many years.

Cese is a PFHA Hall of Fame trainer and Pat has a background in Saddleseat and Western. He and Pat are both PFHA trainers of the year. They have trained many Grand Champion Paso Fino horses, including "Pasion", a Fino Mare who won the Fino Championship when Stallions and Mares competed as one. Cese and Pat have trained multiple "Horses of the Year" and are known today for their honesty, integrity, and hard work. These two work hard every day to promote the Paso Fino horse and exhibit the natural smooth gait that we have all come to love.
