All owners and exhibitors must be current members of the Paso Fino Horse Association (please make sure your membership is current, you may renew at www.pfha.org) and all horses must be registered or have a current show validation certificate with PFHA.

SHOW ENTRY INFORMATION

SHOW SECRETARY: Janice Meyer, Troy, IL. Pre-Entries must be received by June 6, 2024.

Entries received after June 6 will pay a \$25 late fee per horse. Entries may be emailed or entered by the Paso Key system online. For email entries, scan and send to janicemeyer@charter.net. **You only need to send the entry form (front and back) with all information filled in.** All exhibitors should use the standard PFHA entry form with separate signature page for emailed entries.

Exhibitors may also enter using the Paso Key system from the PFHA web site at www.pfha.org. If you enter via Paso Key, it will verify your memberships and registration numbers, but you must download and send your other documents. **PLEASE ONLY SUBMIT ENTRIES BY ONE METHOD.**

At time of check in at the show, you must leave a signed check (made payable to Piedmont PFHA) or a completed credit card authorization form. ENTRY NUMBERS WILL NOT BE ISSUED BY THE SHOW OFFICE WITHOUT EITHER A SIGNED CHECK OR A CC AUTHORIZATION FORM ON FILE. Credit card payments are subject to a 4% service fee.

Bring all necessary paperwork with you at check-in, including registration copies, membership card numbers for owners and exhibitors, and coggins test copies. Health papers will be required for any horse coming from outside of NC for the show, and these must be brought with the horse and shown upon arrival to the show grounds and upon check in at the show office.

Send a stabling form that includes all horses and owners that are to be stabled together, as well as any additional shavings you wish to pre-order, to Milda Minter at pasofinotrainer@gmail.com.

Remember that 4 bags of shavings are included with each stall, including tack stalls. Please only list the EXTRA SHAVINGS that you wish to order on the stabling form. Shavings that come with your stall and any shavings you order before the show will be at your stall upon arrival. *(you are allowed to bring in bagged shavings also)*

When you submit your entry by the June 6 deadline, you do not have to enter all your classes. You must enter at least one class on a completed entry form to be considered "pre-entered." You may add or switch classes at the show with the show secretary. **The show office will be open from 10 am to 7 pm on Thursday and throughout the weekend.**

FEE SCHEDULE FOR ALL HORSES

Stalls: \$150, includes 4 bags of shavings (arrival Wed, June 12, departure Mon, June 17)

Arrivals are allowed on Tuesday, June 11, for \$15 additional per stall, with prior arrangement.

Extra Shavings: \$10 per bag (text show chair 336-225-0214 to order, or order in show office)

Entry Fee: \$60 per class or championship class

Youth Entry Fee: \$45 per class or championship class

Specialty Class Entry Fee: \$45 (costume, western pl, versatility, trail, driving, open or amateur)

Walk-Corto Leadline: \$15 (entry must be made through show secretary)

Late Fee: \$25 per horse (one time fee for horses entered after June 6)

Office Fee: \$15 per horse (one time fee per horse entered in the show)

RV space: \$50 per night, lower level (full hookups, back side of showgrounds, below Barn C)

\$70 per night, upper level (full hookups, beside Barn D and in parking lot of arena)

\$70 per night, prime spaces (full hookups, between arena and Barns A & B, reserved for Diamond and Emerald and Platinum sponsors only)

IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

Please note that the class schedule is different each day. Pay close attention to your class numbers to make sure you enter the proper classes for your division.

All classes will be conducted and judged under current Paso Fino Horse Association and USEF rules and regulations.

This show is sanctioned by USEF as a Lite show. Anyone who signs the entry blank as a trainer must have a current USEF competing membership and be Safe Sport trained before the show. This applies to all adults aged 18 years or older.

Every entry blank must be signed on the trainer line. Therefore, if you are an owner or amateur who is showing without a trainer, or sign as a parent of a youth who is showing without a trainer, you must also sign on the trainer line and therefore you will be required to have a USEF competing membership and be Safe Sport trained before the show. Please visit www.usef.org to join or renew your membership and complete the Safe Sport training before arriving at the show.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.USEF.org.

Pay attention to paddock announcements. Some classes may be small or have no exhibitors, so at times the schedule will move very fast. We will make every attempt to make sure exhibitors are notified of classes in the arena, but exhibitors are responsible for being ready to show when their classes are called to the arena. Once classes are called into the arena, there will be a short gate hold, and then the gate will close. **Once the entry gate has been closed, additional horses will not be permitted to enter and the class will be judged with those present. Entry fees will not be refunded in the case of missed classes.** If you need to scratch a class or classes, please notify the paddock master or show secretary before your class is due to enter the ring. Entry fees may be credited to your account if scratches are made in a timely manner before the class runs.

Futurity classes will be held during the Saturday/Sunday show and must be pre-entered according to futurity rules. Futurity nominated stallions who are present at the show will have the opportunity to participate in stallion exhibitions during the Saturday evening championship session. Make arrangements with Candy if you would like to be included.

DIRECTIONS TO THE FACILITY: The Western NC Agricultural Center is located just off I-26 at the Asheville Regional Airport exit #40. When you get off the exit, go west on Hwy 280 (Airport Rd). go approx 1/2 mile and turn left at the stoplight just past airport entrance onto Fanning Bridge Rd. You will see the showgrounds on the corner and the main gate to the showgrounds is on the right.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS & INFORMATION

ADMISSION OF HORSES: Stalls at regular rate will be available on Wed, June 12, 2024 and must be vacated by Monday, June 17, 2024. Stalls are available on Tuesday, June 11, for early arrival for an additional fee and by prior arrangement. Horses may be stabled only in the stalls designated for their owner by show management. Use of other stalls not designated to you may result in additional fees.

ARENA FOOTING: Sand, sawdust, topsoil mixture, compacted to a medium standard. The competition arena is 120 x 240 ft on the floor with offset arena fence.

AWARDS: Ribbons up to 6th place will be awarded in regular classes. Ribbons will be awarded up to 4th place in championship classes. An honorable mention will be announced for each class. Awards will be announced and presented in reverse order, so the first place horse will be last to be called. Trophies and other prizes may be awarded.

BICYCLES, MOPEDS, SCOOTERS, SKATEBOARDS: Bicycles, mopeds, scooters, skateboards, or any other personal transportation with wheels (including wheeled shoes) may be used **WITH CAUTION** on the show grounds but may **NOT** be ridden or used inside the show arena or on the concourse (excluding necessary and approved medical equipment). This is for safety of horses and people. **Anyone violating this policy will be subject to monetary fines and to confiscation of the equipment until the show is over.** Anyone riding or using these devices anywhere on the show grounds in a reckless or unsafe manner, that could cause injury to a horse or person, will be subject to fines or confiscation of the equipment until the show is over.

BITS: Bits may be checked after any class for the top 3 placements as the horses exit the show arena. Exhibitors should be prepared to drop bits for the show steward and should have an extra handler available if necessary for your horse.

CAMPERS/RVS: Campers and RVs must be parked in designated areas, which are on a "first come, first serve" basis, except for the prime spaces between McGough Arena and Barns A & B, which are reserved for Platinum, Diamond, & Emerald Sponsors. You must see the barn manager to get a RV permit, at which time the electrical boxes will be unlocked. Any vehicle connected to water and/or electricity will be considered a camper and will be charged the camper fee. Campers arriving late after office hours must be prepared to be self-contained if necessary until RV utilities can be unlocked. Camper permits must be prominently displayed on your trailer or motorhome throughout the show.

CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS: Management reserves the right to combine, cancel, or run concurrently any class or classes as needed for the show, or to reschedule classes after notification to exhibitors. Classes will not be split and will be held as included in the show schedule. Management also reserves the right to change or alter the officials listed without notice prior to or during the show. Management is not responsible for cancellations due to severe weather or other emergencies.

CLASS CALLS: Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system. However, due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time.

COGGINS/HEALTH PAPERS: In accordance with North Carolina state law, all horses on the grounds must have a current negative Coggins test certificate (within 12 months). A copy of the certificate must be on

file in the show office. In addition, a copy must be posted on the stall door for inspection by the State Veterinarian. All non-showing horses on the grounds must be listed on an entry blank and present a coggins certificate as listed above. Any horse not in compliance must be removed from the grounds—no exceptions! A health certificate dated within 30 days prior to the end of the show is required for all out of state horses.

CONCESSIONS: The concession stand in the arena will be opening at 8:00 am each day, offering breakfast options, coffee, specialty coffees, tea, other drinks, and sandwiches and snacks. We will have outside food vendors which will be set up between the arena and Barns A & B.

DAMAGE: The Western NC Ag Center holds individual owners and exhibitors responsible for damages incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the show grounds and will bill them accordingly. The Piedmont PFHA, the Asheville Alive Horse Show, and the show management, personnel, or volunteers will in no way be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show, its management, and the W NC Ag Center blameless for any loss or accident to his/her horse(s) or equipment that may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise. The Asheville Alive Horse Show, show management or personnel, or the W NC Ag Center will not be responsible or liable for injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, employees, or any other interested parties.

DISABILITY: If an individual needs an accommodation under the American Disabilities Act, please submit the request, along with the documentation of the disability and need for accommodation, to the show chairman.

DISCOURTESY: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom, may disqualify the horse and cause the owner to forfeit his/her entry fee and other fees.

DISPOSAL OF MEDICAL WASTE: Sharps containers are provided in convenient locations throughout the barns for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. Show management may fine any individuals, including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal.

DOGS ON COMPETITION GROUNDS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained at all times. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted on a horse.

DRUG TESTING: Horses may be randomly drug tested through the USEF drug testing program because this is a USEF Lite show. Exhibitors are not required to pay drug testing fees.

EMERGENCY CARE: Information about local Urgent Care facilities and local hospitals will be available at the show office.

ENTRIES: Entries must be received by June 6 to avoid paying a late fee. Entries must be complete and include signatures and form of payment, either a check or credit card authorization form. A check may be substituted at the show as payment so long as a CC authorization form has been submitted with the entries. **See page 2 of the prize list for submission information.**

FARRIER: Name and number of a farrier will be posted in the barns and at the show office.

GOLF CARTS: **CALL TO RESERVE EARLY!** Note that golf carts are not included in sponsor packages. Contact the show chairman at 336-225-0214 to reserve golf carts.

HOLD HARMLESS: Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to him/her, his/her horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise. All exhibitors must sign a release form.

HOTEL INFORMATION: There are 2 hotels with room blocks reserved for our show. You may contact them directly and mention that you are with the Piedmont Classic Paso Fino Horse Show.

Clarion Inn Asheville Airport, 550 Airport Rd, Fletcher, NC, 28732, (828) 684-1213. You must call the hotel directly to reserve rooms.

Courtyard by Marriott Asheville Airport, 360 Rockwood Rd, Arden, NC, 28704, (828) 684-5000.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

MUSIC: Please be aware that loud music in the barns during show hours can prevent exhibitors from hearing paddock calls for their classes. If complaints are made regarding loud music, exhibitors are expected to comply with show management's request to reduce the volume for the sake of other exhibitors.

NON-SHOWING HORSES: If horses are on the show grounds for any reason that are not entered in the show, those horses must meet all health requirements required by the show, including flu & rhino

vaccine records, coggins tests, and health papers (if from out of state). All non-showing horses must be listed on an entry form with the show office.

PARKING: Horse trailer parking is not permitted in the barn area. **Horse trailers and vans must be parked in designated trailer parking areas on the lower level of the showgrounds.** At all times a fire lane around the barns must be kept clear. Any vehicles or trailers blocking emergency access or parked around the barns may be towed at the owner's expense. Cars and trucks must park in the paved parking lot to the south and east of the McGough Arena., except for the parking spaces reserved for Platinum, Diamond, and Emerald sponsors near barns A & B. Please do not park horse trailers in the paved lot by McGough Arena.

QUESTIONS: Any and all questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management, whose decision shall be final.

REFUNDS: Owners will be responsible for payment of stall fees after June 6 unless a refund request is accompanied by a veterinarian excuse.

RETURNED CHECKS OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS: All checks returned for non-payment, or credit cards that are declined, will be charged a handling fee and must be replaced by cash, certified check, or cashier's check within 2 weeks of notification.

RING CONDUCT: All riders shall be properly attired and horses presented according to the PFHA rules. Attendants should be neatly dressed. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those persons having official or requested duties to perform.

SHAVINGS: Each stall is priced with 4 bags of shavings included. Additional shavings may be purchased through show management. Please text the barn manager at 336-225-0214 to order shavings, or order these at the show office. You may also pre-order extra shavings on the stabling form you send with your entries, and these will be at your stalls when you arrive. **PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE YOUR FIRST 4 BAGS OF SHAVINGS THAT COME WITH YOUR STALLS ON THE STABLING FORM, ONLY INCLUDE ANY EXTRAS THAT YOU WISH TO PRE-ORDER.** Remember you will also receive 4 bags of shavings with each tack stall which can be divided among your horses.

Exhibitors are allowed to bring bagged shavings onto the grounds for their personal stalls.

SHOW OFFICE: The show office will be open on Thursday, June 13, for exhibitor check-ins from 10 am until 7pm. It will also be open one hour before show time on Friday, and 30 minutes before show time on Saturday and Sunday. The show office will close 30 minutes after the completion of the last class each day. Please check out with the show secretary to verify your bill upon completion of your last class for the weekend.

SPONSORSHIPS: Sponsorship packages and class sponsorships are available. Please see the sponsor packages located in this prize list for options. Some packages may already be sold.

STABLING: Stalls are permanent 10 ft x 10 ft with full sliding or swinging doors. Barns A & B have asphalt floors in all stalls. Barns C & D have dirt floors in all stalls. Aisles in all barns are dirt. Stalls must not be altered or damaged in any way and are subject to charge of additional fees for exhibitors for

repair and replacement of parts if stalls are not left in their original condition. Stabling location for the show is at the discretion of show management. Use of stalls other than those assigned to you by show management will result in additional fees being charged.

VENDOR SPACES: Vendor spaces are available for the entire weekend inside the show arena. Contact the show chair for pricing and to reserve space.

VETERINARIAN: Name and number of a veterinarian will be posted in the barns and at the show office.

All other documentation may be brought to the show office at check-in. You may also enter via the PasoKey system online by June 6.

Stabling Forms are due by June 6. Please send these to Milda Minter by email at pasofinotrainer@gmail.com. This allows us to prepare the barns and stalls for your arrival. Move in date is Wednesday, June 12, unless you make arrangement to arrive on Tuesday, June 11. Early arrival on Tuesday is free for Diamond and Platinum sponsors and \$15 per stall for all others.
