SHOW SECRETARY: Andy Smith, Nicholasville, KY. **Entries must be received by Friday, April 18, 2024.** Entries received after April 18 will pay a \$25 late fee per horse. Entries should be emailed; scan and send to andysmithpkt@yahoo.com.

Include all necessary paperwork with your entry packet. A credit card authorization form is required at time of entry. At time of check in at the show, a check may replace a credit card authorization form, but the CC auth form should be sent with all entries to guarantee the pre-entry price so you don't have to pay the late fee. ENTRY NUMBERS WILL NOT BE ISSUED WITHOUT EITHER A SIGNED CHECK OR A CC AUTHORIZATION FORM ON FILE. Credit card payments are subject to a service fee.

To submit entries, include the following documentation:

- PFHA Entry Form and signature page
- Copy of PFHA horse registration, copy of PFHA membership cards for all owners and riders
- Current Coggins test (must be within 1 year of last day of show)
- Credit card authorization form (may be replaced with a check at the show check in)

When you submit your entry packet by the April 18 deadline, you must enter at least one class per horse and have all documentation completed in order to avoid the late fee. You may add additional classes at the show at the regular entry fee.

HOST HOTEL: We have several blocks of rooms reserved in local hotels. Contact the show chairman for the list of hotels. There are many activities besides our show that weekend in the area, so rooms need to be reserved as soon as possible.

FEE SCHEDULE FOR ALL HORSES

Stalls: \$100, includes 3 bags of shavings (arrival Thursday, April 24, departure Mon, April 28)

NO ARRIVALS ARE ALLOWED BEFORE THURSDAY, APRIL 24, at 8:00 am

Extra Shavings: \$10.00 per bag (order through barn manager)

Entry Fee: \$40 per class or championship (all classes except youth)

Youth Entry Fee: \$30 per class or championship

Walk-Corto Leadline: free (entry must be made through show secretary)

Late Fee: \$25 per horse (one time fee for horses entered after April 18)

Office Fee: \$15 per horse (one time fee per horse entered in the show)

Grounds Fee: \$20 per horse per day (for horses not using stalls, showing out of trailer)

RV space: \$50 per night (full hookups) (reserve through the show chairman)

EXTRA WEEKEND EVENTS

- FREE Trail riding all weekend on the adjacent Fant's Grove Trail System. You may reserve RV spaces and stalls through the show. There is a public parking lot for trailers at the trail head located across the road from the arena.
- **Barn Party (potluck)—Friday eve, 6 pm, at the big tent in front of Barn A. All exhibitors welcome!! Please bring a dish or drinks to share.**
- Piedmont PFHA membership meeting—Friday eve, 7 pm, front of Barn A at the big tent

DIRECTIONS TO THE FACILITY

From I-85 Southbound, take exit #19B, proceed West on Hwy 76 for approx 8 miles, look for arena signs on the left side of the divided highway, approx ½ mile past Tri-County Tech College. Make a left and follow that road approx 1 mile to the facility on the left.

From I-85 Northbound, take exit #14, follow Hwy 187 north/west to Hwy 76, go left (west) on Hwy 76, continue several miles, look for arena signs on left side of divided highway, approx ½ mile past Tri-County Tech College. Make a left and follow that road approx 1 mile to the facility on the left.

Note: from Hwy 76, you can also turn left at the stop light in front of Tri-County Tech College, proceed approx 1 mile, see the facility on the right side, make the next right and then go right into the barn area.

IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

Note that the class schedule is different each day. Pay close attention to your class numbers to make sure you enter the proper classes for your division. All classes will be conducted and judged under current Paso Fino Horse Association rules and regulations. Class splits may be made when appropriate in the case of conflict of rider with 2 horses (as in schooling classes, aged gelding classes, etc) but **exhibitors must notify the show secretary of the need for a split at the time the show entries are made.** In this case the class will be split into A and B sections with divisions according to PFHA rules, and all other exhibitors will be notified of the changes. If classes are split, they will follow PFHA rules regarding ages (36-48 months or 49-60 months for schooling age, 61-84 months or 85 months & older for aged horses).

Pay attention to paddock announcements. Please be ready in the warm-up area when it is time for your class. Some classes will be very small or have no exhibitors, so at times the schedule will move very fast. We will make every attempt to make sure exhibitors are notified of classes in the arena, but exhibitors are responsible for being ready to show when their classes are called to the arena. Once classes are called into the arena, there will be a short gate hold, and then the gate will close. Once the entry gate has been closed, additional horses will not be permitted to enter and the class will be judged with those present. **Entry fees will not be refunded in the case of missed classes.** If you need to scratch a class or classes, please notify the paddock master or show secretary before your class is due to enter the ring. Entry fees may be credited to your account if scratches are made in a timely manner before the class runs.

Paperwork should be submitted to the show secretary at the time entries are made, including PFHA entry form and signature pages, PFHA registration copies, PFHA membership card numbers for owners and exhibitors, and coggins tests (within 12 months). **A 30-day Health Certificate will be required for any horse coming from outside of SC for the show,** and this must be brought with the horse and shown upon arrival to the show grounds and upon check in at the show office. If you did not pre-enter by sending all documentation to the show secretary, all paperwork must be brought to the show in order to complete your entries. The late fee will apply to each horse if you do not pre-enter by April 18.

NEW FACILITY RULES FOR 2025: Tape, staples, nails, and screws may not be used to hang decorations or anything else at the stalls. You may only use zip ties or rope or string to hang curtains or other items. Clean-up and repair fees may be charged by the facility and will be paid by the exhibitor for any stall or area that is damaged. Trucks and cars may not park between the barns or on the driveways around the barns or arena. Vehicles must park in designated lots or areas at the ends of the barns, leaving a fire lane directly around all buildings, or in the trailer parking lot to the side of barn A. No vehicle may be parked in the RV spaces unless you are parking beside your RV for which you have paid the RV fee.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

ADMISSION OF HORSES: Stalls will be available on Thursday, April 24, 2025, and must be vacated by Monday, April 28, 2025. Horses may be stabled only in the stalls designated for their owner by show management. Use of other stalls not designated to you may result in additional fees. Horses on the grounds but not using stalls must pay the daily grounds fee. **No arrivals before Thursday April 24!!**

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT: It is important to PFHA that everyone involved in our shows and events has the best experience possible. If you have any needs or ADA accessibility issues which we could address in advance to make your experience better, please contact the show chairman.

ARENA/WORK HOURS: The main show arena will be open on Friday, April 25, from 8am until 11 pm for working horses. It will also be open on Saturday evening after the show until 11 pm. **It will not be open on Thursday, April 24, for horses.** The covered arena, which is used as a warm-up during the show, will be open for use all the time from Thursday through Sunday.

CAMPERS/RVS: Campers and RVs must be parked in designated areas, which are on a “first come, first serve” basis. Electrical boxes on the camper spaces will be locked and you must contact the show chair to have the box unlocked. Any vehicle connected to water and/or electricity will be considered a camper and will be charged the camper fee. Campers arriving late after office hours must be prepared to be self-contained until the office opens and someone can unlock the power box. No campers can be parked around the barns. Campfires are not allowed. Generators are not allowed.

CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS: Management reserves the right to combine, cancel, or run concurrently any class or classes as needed for the show, or to reschedule classes after notification to exhibitors. Management also reserves the right to change or alter the officials listed without notice prior to or during the show. Management is not responsible for cancellations due to severe weather or other emergencies.

CLASS CALLS: Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system. However, due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time.

COGGINS/HEALTH PAPERS: In accordance with South Carolina state law, all horses on the grounds must have a current negative Coggins test certificate (within 12 months). A copy of the certificate must be on file in the show office. In addition, a copy must be posted on the stall door for inspection by the State Veterinarian. All non-showing horses on the grounds must be listed on an entry blank and present a coggins certificate as listed above. Any horse not in compliance must be removed from the grounds—no exceptions! A health certificate dated within 30 days of the end of the show is required for all out of state horses.

DAMAGE: The T Ed Garrison Arena holds individual owners and exhibitors responsible for damages incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the show grounds and will bill them accordingly. The Piedmont PFHA, the Carolina Classic Horse Show, and the show management, personnel, or volunteers will in no way be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show, its management, and the T Ed Garrison Arena blameless for any loss or accident to his/her horse(s) or equipment that may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise. The Carolina Classic Horse Show, show management or personnel, or the T Ed Garrison Arena will not be responsible or liable for injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, employees, or any other interested parties. **New Rules for 2025: screws, nails, screws, and staples may NOT be used for any purpose on any part of the stalls and damage fees may apply if these are found.**

DISABILITY: If an individual needs an accommodation under the American Disabilities Act, please submit the request, along with the documentation of the disability and need for accommodation, to the show chairman.

DISCOURTESY: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom, may disqualify the horse and cause the owner to forfeit his/her entry fee and other fees and be removed from the grounds. This show and the Piedmont PFHA Board of Directors do support and will enforce all PFHA and USEF rules regarding sportsmanship, conduct, and courtesy at all PFHA recognized shows or events. Any violations committed will be subject to appropriate PFHA and USEF penalties.

DISPOSAL OF MEDICAL WASTE: Sharps containers are provided in convenient locations throughout the barns for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. Show management may fine any individuals, including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal.

DOGS ON COMPETITION GROUNDS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained at all times. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted on a horse.

ENTRIES: Entries must be received by Friday, April 18, to avoid paying a late fee. Entries must be complete and include signatures and a credit card authorization form. A check may be substituted at the show as payment so long as a CC authorization form has been submitted with the entries. See the first page of the prize list for submission information.

COMPOSITION OF THE ARENA FOOTING: Sand, sawdust, topsoil mixture, compacted to a medium standard. The competition arena is 120 x 240 ft on the floor with offset arena fence.

FARRIER: The name of a farrier on call will be posted at the show office and in the barns.

HOLD HARMLESS: Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to him/her, his/her horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise. All exhibitors must sign a release form.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Only persons with a valid driver's license from their state of residence will be permitted to operate any motorized vehicle, including but not limited to golf carts, mopeds, scooters, or farm utility vehicles while on the show grounds. Sanctions and penalties may be imposed upon the parent, guardian, or trainer of any minors who violate this policy.

NON-SHOWING HORSES: If horses are on the show grounds for any reason that are not entered in the show, those horses must meet all health requirements required by the show, including flu & rhino vaccine records, coggins tests, and health papers (if from out of state). All non-showing horses must be listed on an entry form with the show office.

PARKING: Horse trailer parking is not permitted in the barn area. Horse trailers and vans must be parked in designated trailer parking areas. **At all times a fire lane around the barns must be kept clear.** Any vehicles blocking emergency access may be towed at the owner's expense. New Rules for 2025: **Vehicles may not park between the barns or on the driveways around the arena or barns. All vehicles must park in designated areas away from the barns.**

QUESTIONS: Any and all questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management, whose decision shall be final.

REFUNDS: Owners will be responsible for payment of stall fees unless a refund request is accompanied by a veterinarian excuse before arrival at the show grounds. If the horse is on the show grounds already, class refunds will be given for scratched classes but full stall fee must be paid.

RETURNED CHECKS OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS: All checks returned for non-payment, or credit cards that are declined, will be charged a handling fee and must be replaced by cash, certified check, or cashier's check within 2 weeks of notification.

RINGSIDE SPONSOR TABLES: Sponsor tables with 8 chairs will be available on the concourse near the show office. Cost is \$250 for the entire show which includes table amenities, class sponsorships, and preferred stall placement in the barns on a first come-first serve basis. Contact the show chairman to reserve these.

SHAVINGS: Each stall is priced with 3 bags of shavings included. Additional shavings may be purchased through show management. **No outside shavings are allowed to be brought onto the show grounds.**

SHOW OFFICE: The show office will be open on Friday afternoon and evening for check-ins. On show days it will be open starting at 7 am and remain open until the last class of the day. You may add or switch classes with the show secretary at least 5 classes ahead of the class you are adding or deleting.

STABLING: Stalls are 10 x 10 ft permanent with sliding or swinging doors. Stalls must not be altered or damaged in any way and are subject to charge of additional fees for exhibitors for repair and replacement of parts if stalls are not left in their original condition. Stabling location for the show is at the discretion of show management. Use of stalls other than those assigned to you by show management will result in additional fees being charged.

VENDOR SPACES: Vendor Spaces are available for the entire weekend for \$125 for a 10 ft x 10 ft space without electrical hookup, or for \$150 for the same space with electrical hookup. The cost for a vehicle or trailer space is \$200 for the weekend. Contact the show chairman to reserve.

VETERINARIANS: The name(s) of veterinarian on call will be posted at the show office and in the barns.
